3. Exhibit A. Services Provided by Contractor

1. Collect and transport to the end user, treatment facility, or processor of waste motor oil from the 350-gallon and larger collection tanks owned by Pacific County and located at the following locations:

Naselle – Junction of Highways 4 and 401;
Raymond – 209 2nd St;
Ocean Park – 21910 Pacific Highway;
Bay Center – 5 Main Street;
Long Beach – 318 N Second St;
Seaview – 5016 Pacific Highway; and
South Bend – 304 Willapa Avenue.

2. Exhibit B. Cost Associated with Waste Oil Management

The CONTRACTOR agrees to pay the County **\$0.25 per gallon** of oil collected. The fee will be submitted with the collection log to the County within thirty (30) days of any services rendered.


