

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN PACIFIC COUNTY

and

Naselle-Grays River Valley SD 155

For use of designated school district facilities during disaster response

Effective date: Aug. 7, 2013

Expiration date: Aug. 6, 2016

USE OF NON-MEDICAL FACILITIES IN THE EVENT OF A MASS MEDICAL EMERGENCY

In the event of a mass medical emergency in Pacific County, medical infrastructure and resources will be quickly committed to providing the necessary treatment and/or prophylaxis to effectively protect county residents and to respond to the incident. Response to such an event may require activation of an Alternate Care Facility (ACF) which will serve as a supplemental venue where medical and supportive care can be provided to victims of a mass casualty or natural disaster. Resources from the state, federal, and private sector may be mobilized as available, and deployed to augment local governmental resources as soon as possible. Effective utilization of those response resources may likewise require activation of an ACF.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Pacific County and Naselle-Grays River School District agree to the following:

1. Facility Space: Pacific County accepts designation of (name of facility) located at (address of facility) as an Alternate Care Facility (ACF), in the event the need arises.
2. Activation of the facility as an ACF: Request to use the facility as an ACF will occur as soon as deemed necessary by the Pacific County Emergency Operations Center. Such use of (name of facility) will be mutually agreed upon by all parties to this agreement.
3. Modification or Suspension of Normal Facility Business Activities: Naselle-Grays River School District agrees to alter or suspend normal operations in support of the ACF as needed.
4. Use of Facility Resources: Naselle-Grays River School District agrees to authorize the use of facility equipment such as kitchens, buildings, lavatories, communications equipment, computers, Internet services, copying equipment, fax machines, etc. Facility resources and associated systems will only be used with facility management authorization and oversight to include appropriate orientation/training as needed.
5. Costs: All reasonable and eligible costs associated with the emergency and the operation of the ACF that include modifications or damages to the facility structure, equipment and associated systems directly related to their use in support of the ACF facility operations will be documented and submitted for consideration and reimbursement through established disaster assistance programs.
6. Liability: The parties are bound by the Revised Code of Washington Chapter 38.52.180, which addresses immunity from liability for services rendered voluntarily and without compensation in support of emergency operations during an emergency or disaster, meaning an event or set of circumstances which: (i) Demands immediate action to preserve public health, protect life, protect public property, or to provide relief to any stricken community overtaken by such occurrences, or (ii) reaches such a dimension or degree of destructiveness as to warrant the governor declaring a state of emergency pursuant to RCW 43.06.010.

7. Contact Information: Naselle-Grays River School District will provide the Pacific County Emergency Operations Center the appropriate facility 24 hour/7 day contact information, and update this information as necessary.

8. Duration of Agreement: The term of this MOU is three years from the date of the initial agreement. Subsequent terms may be longer with the concurrence of all parties.

9. Agreement Review: A review will be initiated by Pacific County within three years after the effective date of this agreement. Review of this agreement will also occur in a timely manner following any disaster event that has required activation of the ACF. At time of review, this agreement will be considered for modification and for renewal.

10. Structural Modifications: Any changes at the facility that could impact the execution of this agreement will be conveyed to the director(s) of Pacific County Department of Emergency Management and/or Pacific County Health and Human Services Department as soon as possible.

11. Amendments: This agreement may be amended at any time by signature approval of the signatories or their respective designees.

12. Termination of Agreement: Any Party may withdraw at any time from this MOU, except during declared emergency, by transmitting a signed statement to that effect to the other Parties. This MOU will be considered terminated thirty (30) days from the date the non-withdrawing Party receives the notice of withdrawal from the withdrawing Party.


