

Memorandum of Understanding
Between
Pacific County Health Department
And
The Pacific County Sherriff's Office

This Memorandum of Understanding between Pacific County Health & Human Services (PCHHS) and the Pacific County Sherriff's Office (PCSO) for services related to the Enforcing Underage Drinking Laws Grant (EUDL).

1. All services provided under the EUDL grant and covered by this MOU are to take place in South Pacific County (as defined by Ocean Beach School District Boundaries). It is mutually agreed that the Pacific County Sherriff's office will provide the following services to take place between October 1, 2012 and September 31, 2013:
 - (4) 8 hour compliance check shifts
 - (5) 8 hour party patrol shifts
 - (4) 8 hour shoulder tapping shifts
 - 5 deputies attend 3 hour Party Patrol/Source Investigation training
 - 5 deputies attend 2 hour Alcohol Identification & Intervention Training
 - 2 deputies attend 2 hour compliance check/shoulder tapping training
2. The dates for activities will depend on the area's need, as mutually determined by the PCSO and Pacific County Health & Human Services Department.
3. The Pacific County Sherriff's Office shall provide activity reports to the Pacific County Health & Human Service Coordinator on a monthly basis along with an invoice for services. The activity reports shall include, but not be limited to, the following information:
 - ❖ Personnel who completed activities and/or training
 - ❖ Dates and times enforcement activities occurred
 - ❖ Number of contacts made including:
 - Violations
 - Warnings
 - Other dispositions as applicable
4. This agreement may be amended by mutual agreement of the parties. Amendments are not binding unless they are in writing and signed by persons authorized to bind each of the parties.
5. Either party may terminate this agreement upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other party. If this agreement is terminated, the parties shall be liable only for performance rendered or costs incurred prior to the effective date of termination.
