

AMENDMENT NO. 1 INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT NO. C1200016  
BETWEEN  
THE STATE OF WASHINGTON DEPARTMENT OF ECOLOGY  
AND  
PACIFIC COUNTY

PURPOSE: To amend the above-referenced interagency agreement between the Department of Ecology, herein after referred to as ECOLOGY, and Pacific County, herein after referred to as the PROVIDER.

The effective date of this amendment is **January 1, 2013**

This agreement shall expire no later than **June 30, 2013**

**IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED** that the agreement is amended as follows:

**A. TASK 1: Litter and Illegal Dump Cleanup**

The state funding for this task is decreased by \$4,500. The existing Maximum Eligible Cost is changed to the following:

Maximum Eligible Cost: \$50,251

The existing Schedule, Goal Statement, Project Description, Eligible Costs, and Community Investments remain unchanged. The Expected Outcomes/Impacts are changed as follows:

Expected Outcomes/Impacts:

260	Road miles to be cleaned	5,000	Pounds of litter collected
10	Acres to be cleaned	9,000	Pounds of debris from illegal dumps
20	Illegal dump sites to be cleaned	620	Supervisor hours
2,400	Pounds of material recycled	2,150	Total crew hours

**B. TASK 2: Tsunami Debris Coordination**

A new task is formed. \$4500 is transferred to this task from Task 1. This new task and is fully described below:

Maximum Eligible Cost: \$4,500

Schedule: January 1, 2013 – June 30, 2013

Goal Statement:

The PROVIDER will provide an Americorps volunteer coordinator for the coordination of tsunami debris clean-up on all the beaches in Pacific County.

Project Description:

The Americorps volunteer will work full-time, 40 hours a week, and will develop and implement volunteer operations concerning the cleanup of all tsunami debris which may accumulate on the beaches in Pacific County from January 1, 2013 through June 30, 2013. Cleanup will occur along the Long Beach Peninsula and Grayland, Tokeland, and the North

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Cover areas. In addition, the volunteer coordinator will be required to interface with existing persons and organizations that have assisted and worked with the tsunami debris effort in Washington State to date. The volunteer coordinator will make sure to coordinate with a contact person from Washington State Parks, and will remain in communication with this person throughout the extent of this project. Coordinator will respond to volunteers by providing hospitality, guidance, and direction.

Eligible Costs:

\$4,500 pays for the funding match of the Americorps volunteer.

Community Investments:

Pacific County Emergency Management offices will be responsible for the training and orientation of the volunteer. The City of Long Beach will provide a workstation for use by the member at the Long Beach City Hall.

Expected Outcomes/Impacts:

The volunteer coordinator will work approximately 1008 hours, and will contact a minimum of 500 volunteers over the course of the assignment.

It is unknown how much tsunami debris shall wash up on the beaches, so litter pickup and recycling numbers cannot be estimated for this task.

**Progress Reports:** The volunteer coordinator will track all efforts and produce a quarterly report which will be sent to Megan McNelly of Pacific County Public Works at the end of each remaining quarter in the contract, who will submit to ECOLOGY with the payment requests.

In the event that tsunami debris is collected during the quarter, this report shall summarize the following: volunteer coordinator's hours worked for the quarter and a summary of all pick-up efforts, including location, number of volunteers participating in the event (crew hours), composition of litter picked up, pounds of litter, and amounts recycled.

If no tsunami debris is picked up, the summary will include hours worked by the volunteer, and a summary of all planning and coordination efforts undertaken during the quarter.

C. The existing CLCP BUDGET and FUND SOURCE changed to the following:
