

**AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO AGREEMENT NO. G1200374**

**BETWEEN THE**

**STATE OF WASHINGTON DEPARTMENT OF ECOLOGY**

**AND**

**PACIFIC COUNTY**

**Purpose:** To amend the above referenced grant agreement between the Department of Ecology (Department) and Pacific County (Recipient) due to the DEPARTMENT not implementing Mercury Containing Light Law (Chapter 70.275 RCW) as originally planned on January 1, 2013. This amendment will reduce the maximum eligible cost of this agreement to an amount the Recipient is able to spend by June 30, 2013.

**IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED that the agreement is amended as follows:**

1. The maximum eligible cost for this agreement is reduced by \$98,327 from \$182,820 to a total of \$84,493. The state share amount for this agreement is reduced by \$73,745.25 from \$137,115 to a total of \$63,369.75.

3. The expected outcomes remain the same.
4. In order to continue to allow grant reimbursement for expenses related to the Mercury Containing Light Law, IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED to amend the grant agreement as follows:
  - A. Language (term and condition) in the grant agreement currently states:

As of January 1, 2013, expenses covered under the implementation of the Mercury Containing Lights Law (Chapter 70.275 RCW), will not be eligible for CPG reimbursement. Consult your grant office for more information.

The language shall be replaced with the following:

Expenses relating to the collection and recycling of mercury containing lights shall be eligible for CPG reimbursement until such time that the Mercury Light Recycling program is fully implemented or the grant agreement expires, whichever is the earliest date.
5. The effective date of this amendment is January 1, 2013.
6. All other terms and conditions of the original agreement and any amendments remain in full force and effect.
