1. The purpose of this amendment is to:
Remove the remaining unspent Triple P Service funds from the July 2011 through June 2013 time period in the amount of \$12,893, which is funded by MHBG, CFDA #93.959.
2. The attached Awards and Revenues Page (A&R), Exhibit A, replaces the July 2011 through June 2013 A&R.
3. The maximum consideration for the Contract is decreased by \$12,893 to \$1,038,990.
