- Announcements
 - Planning Commission
 - CAO is next
 - Wanting adequate development, but also creating environmental protections
 - Buffers might be larger than they are now
 - Don't want a variance on every application
 - It will overwhelm staff and Hearings Examiner
 - It would be nice to have Rick Mraz come in and present to the group
 - TNC Contributions
 - Sea Level Affecting Marshes Model (SLAMM)
 - It is being included into the SIAC Report
 - Modeling from LIDAR data
 - Willapa SAMP
 - TNC will support a Special Area Management Plan (SAMP) and will champion it
 - Discussion of what the “special area” is and what it would do for the county
 - A discussion to see if it is something that the MRC would be interested in moving forward and looking at

 - Restoration Plan

- SMP Review
 - Group discussed the comments that were made by others
 - Aquaculture section was addressed
 - Over-water structures were discussed for existing over-water structures in high intensity areas
 - Discussion about what this would look like and the information from the proponents and the opposition
 - Dune habitat discussion
 - Primary dunes will be left and people will be prevented from getting their ocean view
 - Discussion about HAT versus OHWM and the importance of using HAT on the east side of the Peninsula, but not the OHWM
