RESOLUTION NO. 99-069

A RESOLUTION REGARDING THE SETTING OF FEES, ADMINISTRATION AND ACCEPTANCE OF SURETY PERTAINING TO ORDINANCE NO. 113 (ROAD HAUL PERMITS) AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 91-087 DATED MAY 21, 1991, AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 91-087 AMENDED DATED DECEMBER 10, 1991

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 91-087 was signed by the Board of Pacific County Commissioners on the 21st day of May in the year 1991 and Resolution No. 91-087 Amended was signed by the Board of Pacific County Commissioners on the 10th day of December in the year 1991;

WHEREAS, these resolutions provided that in accordance with the provisions of RCW 46.44.093 the Board of County Commissioners authorizes Road Haul Permits to be issued following certain criteria;

WHEREAS, a recommendation has been received from the County Engineer to update and amend the criteria for issuing Road Haul Permits;

WHEREAS, a recommendation has been received to rescind Resolution No. 91-087 and Resolution No. 91-087 Amended;

WHEREAS, a recommendation has been received to adopt the criteria listed in Appendix "A" including example drawings labeled Exhibit "1" and Exhibit "2";

WHEREAS, these recommendations will improve and facilitate the administration of Road Haul Permits in accordance with Ordinance No. 113 and No. 113A; now therefore


IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that Resolution No. 91-087 and Resolution No. 91-087 Amended are hereby rescinded; and


IT IS STILL FURTHER RESOLVED that the updated criteria will be effective immediately.





Appendix "A"

The following criteria shall be used for administering Ordinance Nos. 113 and 113A regarding fees for Road Haul Permits and accepting surety for potential damage to weight restricted roads:

- A. The Road Haul Permit application fee shall be \$20.
- B. Surety may be in the form of a cash deposit with Pacific County, a letter of credit from a bank, a certified bond, a cashier's check or certified check payable to Pacific County, Department of Public Works.
- C. The formula for computing surety for road damage is the quantity of loads multiplied by the miles multiplied by the repair factor for the surface type.
- D. The minimum surety shall be \$300.
- E. The maximum limit for surety shall be \$50,000.
- F. Securities shall be received by the County Engineer or his/her designee.
- G. Securities shall be immediately placed in the care and safe keeping of the Pacific County Department of Public Works Accounting Division Manager.
- H. At the conclusion of the activity or ending date of road restrictions the road will be reviewed and evaluated by the Department of Public Works for estimated repairs. The normal maintenance cost is deemed to be \$2,500/mile. The cost of repairs over and above normal maintenance will be prorated to each permittee based on the rate formula listed in Section K. Repair costs over and above normal maintenance for each permittee shall be deducted from the surety. The remainder of the surety shall then be returned to the permittee. If the surety is not sufficient to cover the amount of the damage, the permittee is still responsible for paying the remaining amount of the damage unless Section J applies.
- I. 50 Load Exemption. Up to and including 50 loads may be hauled annually over a given weight restricted County road segment for each affected land owner hauling on these routes before surety is required. These 50 loads shall be exempted from charges for the costs of repairs over and above normal maintenance.

Where more than one direction over a given weight restricted County road can be used to access the same location, the 50 load exemption will be applied only once per affected land owner—as if all loads are hauled in one direction from a given site. Exhibits "1" and "2" (attached) provide examples for the meaning of this Section I.


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- J. Flat Rate Option. Those obtaining permits have the option to pay a flat \$4 per load-mile charge on affected haul route segments for load counts that are greater than 50 but less than or equal to 250 in lieu of providing surety. The charges for costs of repairs over and above normal maintenance shall not exceed \$4 per load-mile for load counts greater than 50 but less than or equal to 250.

When costs of repairs over and above normal maintenance are less than \$4 per load-mile for load counts greater than 50 but less than or equal to 250, a refund may be issued to the affected permittee upon request.

- K. The actual rate of the cost of repairs over and above normal maintenance is determined by dividing the total cost of these repairs by the total number of loads (including exempt loads) multiplied by the distance hauled over the affected road:

$$\text{Rate} = \frac{\text{(total cost of repairs above normal maintenance for affected road segment)}}{\text{(total number of permitted loads on road segment including exempt loads) x (length hauled over affected road)}}$$




JONES RECEIVES ONE 50 LOAD EXEMPTION
