ORDINANCE NO. 148-C

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 148, ORDINANCE No. 148-A  
AND ORDINANCE NO. 148-B RELATING TO  
REVENUE AND FINANCE: AMENDING SECTION 6 - EFFECTIVE DATE AND DURATION.

WHEREAS, with enactment of Engrossed Second Substitute House Bill 5557 (Chapter 478, Laws of 2007), the legislature found that while Washington's economy is currently prospering, economic growth continues to be uneven, particularly as between metropolitan and rural areas; and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Legislature authorized a rate increase of one one-hundredths percent (0.01%) in the sales and use tax imposed by Ordinance No. 148B adopted by the Pacific County Board of Commissioners on June 26, 2007 and effective August 1, 2007 adjusting the sales and use tax from eight one-hundredths percent (0.08%) to nine one-hundredths percent (0.09%) and

WHEREAS, with enactment of Substitute House Bill 1751 (Chapter 511, Laws of 2009), the legislature found that for counties imposing the tax at the rate of nine one-hundredths percent (0.09%) before August 1, 2009, the tax expires on the date that is twenty-five years after the date that the 0.09 percent tax rate was first imposed; and

WHEREAS, notice having been given and a hearing having been conducted thereupon in accordance with RCW 36.32.120, this ordinance is found to be in the best interest of Pacific County; now, therefore,


IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS,  
PACIFIC COUNTY, WASHINGTON, that Pacific County Ordinance No. 148, Ordinance No. 148A and Ordinance No. 148B are amended as follows:

**SECTION 6 – Effective Date and Duration:** The sales and use tax authorized by this Ordinance shall become effective August 1, 2007 and shall remain in effect for a period of twenty-five (25) years, expiring at 12:01 a.m. on August 1, 2032.

PASSED by the Board of Pacific County Commissioners meeting in regular session at South Bend, Washington, by the following vote, then signed by its membership and attested to by its Clerk in authorization of such passage the 8<sup>th</sup> day of September 2009;






