

BEFORE THE BOARD OF PACIFIC COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

ORDINANCE NO. 106

IN THE MATTER OF THE DISSOLUTION OF DIKING DISTRICT NO.1  
OF PACIFIC COUNTY, COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS "WALLICUT DIKING  
DISTRICT".

WHEREAS, Allen J. Goulter notified this Board in a memo dated 17 March, 1986 that it appeared that Diking District No. 1 of Pacific County has ceased to function as a district organization; and,

WHEREAS, Robert Johnson-County Auditor notified this Board in accordance with the provisions of RCW 36.96.020 in a memo dated 9 May, 1986 that Diking District No. 1 of Pacific County appeared to be inactive, as defined by RCW 36.96.010(3)(b), in that his records reflected the last election for commissioners of Diking District No. 1 was held in 1978; and,

WHEREAS, this Board held a public hearing 12 June, 1986 to determine if Diking District No. 1 of Pacific County met either criteria for being "inactive", as defined by RCW 36.96.010, and to dissolve said district pursuant to the procedure set forth in RCW 36.96.030 through .080; and,

WHEREAS, comments rendered by interested parties at said hearing emphasized that Diking District No. 1 was inactive and that said district should be dissolved in as much as the main purpose of said district is now the base for the local public road system and thereby maintained by multi-purpose local government rather than special purpose government, now, therefore,

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, COUNTY OF PACIFIC, STATE OF WASHINGTON, that:

- Diking District No. 1 of Pacific County, more commonly referred to as Wallicut Diking District, is found to meet the criteria of being "inactive", as defined by RCW 36.96.010.
- The main purpose that said district was established is found to have been assumed by other units of multi-purpose general government which is further found to better serve the public's interest.
- Diking District No.1 (Wallicut) of Pacific County is hereby dissolved and except for the purpose of winding up its affairs as provided by RCW 36.96, said district shall cease to exist thirty-one days after adoption of this dissolution ordinance.
