BEFORE THE BOARD OF PACIFIC COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

ORDINANCE NO. 107

IN THE MATTER OF THE DISSOLUTION OF LEBAM WATER DISTRICT, ELK CREEK WATER DISTRICT, TOKELAND WATER DISTRICT, WALLICUT WATER DISTRICT, EKLUND PARK SEWER DISTRICT, DIKING DISTRICT #4, DIKING DISTRICT #5, AND DIKING DISTRICT #6.

WHEREAS, Robert Johnson-County Auditor notified this Board in accordance with the provisions of RCW 36.96.020 in a memo dated 9 May, 1986 that the above mentioned districts appeared to be inactive, as defined by RCW 36.96.010(3)(b), in that his records reflected last elections for Lebam Water District was 1953, Elk Creek Water District was 1979, Tokeland Water District was 1940, Wallicut Water District was 1932, Eklund Park Sewer District was 1979, Diking District No. 4 was 1919, Diking District No. 5 was 1924, and Diking District No. 6 was 1950; and,

WHEREAS, this Board held a public hearing 23, September, 1986 to determine if the above mentioned Districts of Pacific County met either criteria for being "inactive", as defined by RCW 36.96.010, and to dissolve said districts pursuant to the procedure set forth in RCW 36.96.030 through .080; and,

WHEREAS, comments rendered at said hearing emphasized that the above mentioned Districts were inactive and that said Districts should be dissolved in as much as the purposes of said districts are no longer necessary or being operated and maintained by private citizens and property owners; now therefore,

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, COUNTY OF PACIFIC STATE OF WASHINGTON, that:

- Lebam Water District, Elk Creek Water District, Tokeland Water District, Wallicut Water District, Eklund Park Sewer District, Diking District No. 4, Diking District No. 5, and Diking District No. 6, are found to meet the criteria of being "inactive" as defined by RCW 36.96.010.
- The main purposes that said Districts were established are found to no longer be necessary or have been assumed by private citizens or property owners which is further found to better serve the public's interest.
- The above mentioned Districts of Pacific County are hereby dissolved and except for the purpose of winding up their affairs as provided by RCW 36.96, said Districts shall cease to exist thirty-one days after adoption of this dissolution ordinance.
