

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO BRUSH ON COUNTY RIGHT OF WAY:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, PACIFIC COUNTY, STATE OF WASHINGTON, as follows:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, private utility, public utility or other legal entity to cut brush, tress or other vegetation on county right of ways and leave same on the right of ways, Providing that the foregoing shall not apply if brush is piled and burned or otherwise disposed of.

SECTION 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this order shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$10.00 dollars nor more than \$100.00 or to imprisonment in the county jail for not less than thirty (30) days.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety and shall take affect immediately.
