CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION

The Civil Service Commission administers criteria for employment within the Pacific County Sheriff's Office. In accordance with RCW 41.14.030, applicants must be a citizen of the United States, a resident of Pacific County for at least two (2) years preceding appointment, and an elector of Pacific County. At the time of appointment not more than two commissioners shall be adherents of the same political party.
