MEETING - The purpose of the meeting will be to review standard business items before the Planning Commission Board (minutes, elections, etc.). WORKSHOP – Pacific County is conducting a required periodic review of its Shoreline Master Program (SMP). In adherence to state law, the SMP is a comprehensive plan that guides the development, conservation, and restoration of Pacific County's shoreline. The purpose and scope of the 2022-2023 Periodic Review is to, align the SMP with applicable state laws and guidelines in effect at the time of the review; assure consistency of the SMP with the Pacific County Comprehensive Plan and development regulations; and provide existing code clarifications to improve usability and predictability for applicants and reviewers.

The purpose of this initial workshop is to introduce the Planning Commission to the proposed amendments. Additional workshops may be scheduled as necessary. At the conclusion of the workshop phase, Pacific County will initiate the public review/comment period, formal public hearing/review process and adoption.
