Contractor's Conditions

Attachment "A"

- **REQUIRED:**

- All equipment operations including move in, unloading, final clean-up, and reloading shall only be permitted during daylight hours but no earlier than 8:00 a.m. or after 4:00 p.m, Monday—Friday. Department of Community Development's office is closed Fridays, prior permit application must be made to haul on Fridays. Sand removal/hauling is not allowed on weekends, holidays, clam tides, other local events, or as deemed by Pacific County.
 - **RECOMMENDED:**
 - Consider the effect of noise, dust, and the overall impact heavy equipment has on the public. Sand removal is discourage whenever heavy public use of the approaches are encounter. Safety of the public is critical.
- Trucks shall conform to or exceed all State and Federal Department of Transportation regulations related to highway operations. All regulatory and warning signs shall be obeyed.
 - **RECOMMENDED:**
 - Speed should be kept to less than posted while in residential areas. Remove any sand that would spill over side boards before leaving the beach area.
- During sand removal operations, the contractor shall maintain an accessible and usable beach approach for the public. Shall grade the approach periodically during the day, shall grade the approach prior to extended shut down during the day and shall grade the approach at the close of the day. Should the shale surfaced approach become muddy due to rain, the contactor will cover the approach area being used for sand hauling with 1-1/2 inch minus gravel.
- Removal of sand shall not exceed a depth of 18 inches below the approach road. Side slopes shall be 3:1 or less (etc. 6:1). Pit type excavation which must be later filled, is not allowed.
- Portable traffic control signs conforming to the "MANUAL OF UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES" shall be used during the hours of operations. One sign shall be placed in a location readily visible at the end of the asphalt and one shall be readily visible from the state highway. Minimum size shall be 36" x 35" and display "ROAD MACHINERY AHEAD".
- Equipment unmanned shall be parked in a safe manner, engine off, loader buckets down, and off the traveled roadway.
 - ◇ Be aware of other users on the beach approach, children and on lookers may not be aware of the operators limited visibility.
 - ◇ Keep the area of operations in a safe condition at all times.
 - ◇ Failure to obtain a Pacific County Permit prior to any removal of sand or operating procedures out of compliance to this policy could be construed as public theft or endangering public safety. Therefore, the appropriate action will be taken.

REMOVAL OF SAND IS LIMITED TO EXCESS WIND BLOWN SAND WITHIN THE COUNTY RIGHT-OF-WAY ONLY. THIS PERMIT DOES NOT AUTHORIZED THE REMOVAL OF SAND FROM ADJOINING PROPERTIES NOR STATE PARK LAND.
