

WHEREAS the legislature has empowered the legislative authority of the County to make and enforce police regulations that are not in conflict with State law within the unincorporated area of the County, and

WHEREAS the legislative authority of Pacific County has deemed it necessary to adopt a Traffic Code for the regulation of traffic and automobiles in the unincorporated areas of Pacific County, and

WHEREAS Chapter 54 of Washington Laws, 1975, First Extraordinary Session has set out a model traffic ordinance for cities, towns and counties for adoption by reference for this purpose,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED Pacific County adopts as an Ordinance by reference Chapter 54 of Washington Laws, 1975, First Extraordinary Session, except those specific sections as listed below, which are not adopted by this Ordinance. The sections of Chapter 54 of Washington Laws, 1975, First Extraordinary Session which are not adopted by Pacific County in this Ordinance by Section number are as follows:
