

ATTACHMENT A - FAIR CAMPING POLICY

RESOLUTION NO. 2019- 008

1. All Campers must check in at the Fair Office located at 5 Fair Lane by 12:00pm on the first day of the fair.
2. Campers will pick up their parking pass, obtain assigned campsite # and a map.
 - One parking pass will be provided with each campsite.
 - Parking spaces for the tow vehicle will be directly behind the fair office.
3. Check out is allowed Saturday after 9:00pm or Sunday morning when the gates open.
4. Access to assigned parking space will be allowed by fair staff during hours of fair operation.
 - The assigned parking pass and wristband will be checked prior to re-entry.
5. The Fair Office drive through gate will remain unlocked during the fair.
6. A security guard will secure the fair office gate and provide access to parking between the hours of 12:00am and 7:00am daily.
 - The assigned parking pass and wristband will be checked prior to re-entry.
7. The Viking Way arena gate will be locked at 12:00pm on the first day of the fair and remain locked during fair week and will reopen at 9:00pm on Saturday.
8. In the event of an emergency, contact the Fair Office and assistance will be provided in exiting through the Viking Way arena gate.
 - RV/trailer re-entry will not be allowed.
 - Use of assigned parking space for tow vehicle will be allowed.
