

2019 WRISTBANDS

In 2019 the Pacific County Fair has gone to a fair wristband instead of a fair button for a seasonal pass into the fair. These wristbands are widely used in a variety of venues like; fairs, water parks, concerts, auto races and various other activities. They are waterproof and washed easily if needed.

We will also be using a daily wristband for those who come to the fair for a day. They are easily worn, not like a button pinned to your clothing, but loosely around your wrist so they do not come off.

The wristband must be worn in order to enter the fairgrounds. They are put onto your wrist, loosely yet secure. They must not be able to come off of your wrist. If they do slip over your wrist, then you are required to purchase a daily entrance into the fair. There is no exception to this policy.

We do have the senior, over 60, and veteran FREE day which is on Friday, as we have had in the past. On those days, for seniors and veterans a wristband is not required.

Wristband Sales will be through our Ambassador program. The fair Ambassador Candidate(s) will post the various community locations that have wristbands available and they also will be at club functions, activities and businesses selling the seasonal wristbands for the Pacific County Fair until Monday May 19th at noon. They seasonal four-day pass costs \$10.00.

For those who are button collectors, we will have fair buttons with the theme for sale at the fair at a nominal cost.
